Income Guidelines for SVdP Pharmacy

The chart below shows the National Federal Poverty Level for 2019. (Source: ASPE, <https://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty-guidelines>)

St. Vincent de Paul Pharmacy is able to serve residents of Texas whose income is less than 2x the Federal Poverty Level for their household size.

2019 National Federal Poverty Level (FPL)				
Household Size	Annual	Monthly	Biweekly	Weekly
1	\$12,490	\$1,041	\$480	\$240
2	\$16,910	\$1,409	\$650	\$325
3	\$21,330	\$1,778	\$820	\$410
4	\$25,750	\$2,146	\$990	\$495
5	\$30,170	\$2,514	\$1,160	\$580
6	\$34,590	\$2,883	\$1,330	\$665
7	\$39,010	\$3,251	\$1,500	\$750
8	\$43,430	\$3,619	\$1,670	\$835
For each additional person, add:	\$4,420	\$368	\$170	\$85

EXAMPLE

You have two children, and you make \$1000 every two weeks. For a Household size of **3** with a **Biweekly** paycheck, the Federal Poverty Level is **\$820**.

$$\$820 \times 2 = \$1640$$

$$\$1640 = 200\% \text{ (or } 2x) \text{ of the FPL for a household size of } 3$$

$$\$1000 \text{ (biweekly income)} < \$1640$$

Since \$1000 **biweekly** is less than \$1640 (2x FPL for a Household size of **3**), your income meets that criteria!
