## Patient Eligibility

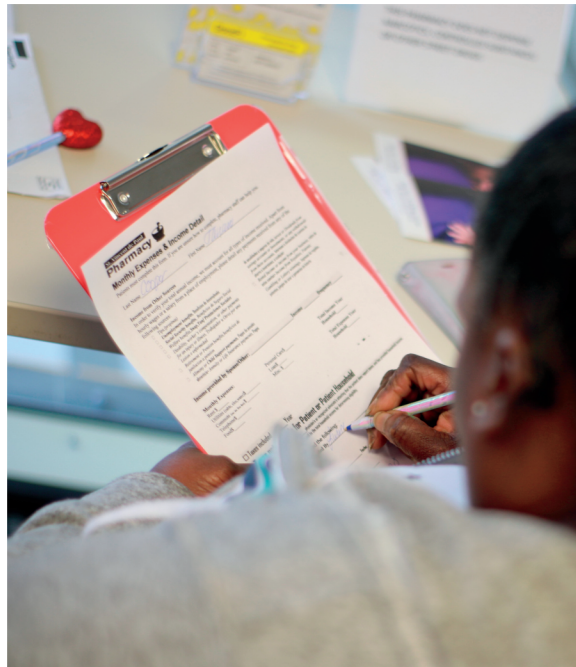
SVdP Pharmacy provides prescription medication for free to patients who:

1. Are residents of Texas
2. Have a household income at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty level for your family's size
3. Have no health insurance
4. Have a valid prescription

- One on One application assistance
- Delivery Assistance (to your clinic or home)



## Applying for Service

Each applicant must fill out the pharmacy application form; you will also need to provide documentation to prove that you qualify, like a photo ID and a tax return.
